## Advanced Biofuels USA Announces Plans to Exhibit and Speak at Congressional Renewable Energy & Energy Efficiency EXPO and Forum June 12

**For Immediate Release June 11, 2013—Frederick, MD** Advanced Biofuels USA, an internationally respected nonprofit educational organization dedicated to promoting the understanding, development and use of advanced biofuels as an energy security, economic development, military flexibility and climate change/pollution control solution announced it will participate in the 16th Annual Congressional Renewable Energy & Energy Efficiency EXPO + Forum on Wednesday, June 12th in Washington, D.C., with an exhibit and speaker.

According to Advanced Biofuels USA's executive director, Joanne Ivancic, "For the third year, we are looking forward to the opportunity to answer questions from legislators and their staff, and from interested general public about sometimes controversial biofuels."

The event, sponsored by the U.S. Sustainable Energy Coalition, features cooperation among members of the U.S. House of Representatives and U.S. Senate Renewable Energy & Energy Efficiency Caucuses. This year's EXPO will bring together nearly fifty sustainable energy industry trade associations, government agencies, businesses, and energy policy research organizations. EXPO programs will showcase the status and near-term potential of several renewable energy options, such as biofuels/biomass, geothermal, hydropower, solar, and wind, as well as energy efficiency technologies including fuel cells, and CHP.
