Theophilus Kumah, a recent Chemical Engineering graduate of Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology in Ghana, is volunteering with Advanced Biofuels USA as a writer. His latest article explores jatropha as a feedstock for biofuels development in Ghana.

Kumah concludes that if Jatropha should get the same level of attention given to ethanol from sugarcane or lignocellulosic biomass, jatropha could be extracted in commercial quantities. 


