Learn more about ARPA-E’s mission, funding opportunities, and hear advice from prior grant recipients. Speakers: Dr. Madhav Acharya serves as a Technology-to-Market Advisor at the Department of Energy's Advanced Research Projects Agency-Energy (ARPA-E). He will also discuss ARPA-E’s current funding opportunity, [OPEN](#), which is a rare non-technology-specific solicitation occurring every three years (deadline for concept papers: Feb. 12, 2018).
