Thoughts from the Fuel Ethanol Workshop and National Advanced Biofuels Conference and Expo

Advanced Biofuels USA board member, Doug Root, attended FEW and the concurrent National Advanced Biofuels Conference and Expo and shared his thoughts and insights.



He observed that the general session panels covered more detail about the export challenges and the needed partnerships with retailers and auto manufacturers in the domestic market to allow wider availability of higher ethanol blends (E15 and above).

Increased awareness that ethanol is the lowest cost and 'greenest' octane enhancer is needed. Auto manufacturers trying to meet their commitments to higher fuel economy will

need to utilize higher compression engines and higher octane fuels which are likely to contain much more than 10% ethanol.

Ethanol producers are looking for greater diversity in products and the technology providers have options ready for 'bolt-on' additions that allow pre-fermentation extraction of corn oil, improved recovery of Distiller Corn Oil (DCO), conversion of DCO to biodiesel, and 'front-end' fractionation into corn bran, corn germ, and fermentable corn starch. There appear to be several options for production of cellulosic ethanol within the



existing fermenters at operating ethanol plants with at least one option requiring no additional equipment. <u>READ MORE</u>
