Students Study Possible Use of Lake Algae for Biofuel

Could the algae on Lake Menomin make biofuel? That is the question some University of Wisconsin-Stout students looked at as part of their research for capstone projects.

The group looked into creating a prototype of an algae collection system. Using a pump, the system would take in water from Lake Menomin. The water would go through an electro-coagulator that would create bubbles to push the algae to the top of a collection box. The algae then would be brushed off the top and placed into a collection area, and the clean water would return to the lake.

"We were trying to find an efficient way to separate the algae from the water," Jerica Hall said, noting the brush system appeared like it would work the best and be the most cost-effective. READ MORE


