



An Open Letter to Tom Steyer

Advanced Biofuels USA asks, "Will Tom Streyer invest as much in renewable transportation fuels as the Koch brothers?"



Dear Mr. Steyer:

According to a <u>Washington Post article</u> on June 9th 2014, you will be <u>divested</u> of all your investments in fossil fuel enterprises by the end of this month. As the article discussed, that meant you continued to make considerable sums of money from these high CO2 producing entities, even as you said you were providing the financial firepower to fight Climate Change by focusing on campaign donations to like-minded Democratic candidates.

More troubling though, is that as a very knowledgeable and successful energy investor now committed to fighting Climate Change you do not appear to have invested in Climate Change reduction technologies such as Advanced Biofuels and Bioproducts.

Why is that Mr. Steyer?

Are struggling advanced biofuel companies perceived as too risky for your portfolio? Do political campaigns provide a better Return on Investment (ROI) than these emerging technologies?



We think these questions are especially relevant given that the Koch brothers, whom you consider your Climate Change enemy, provide considerably more investment and job creation via the biofuels industry – their Flint Hills Resources makes over 600 million gallons/year of ethanol, as well as biodiesel.

It would seem reasonable then, that their Flint Hills commitment should be the minimum investment benchmark for you as well.

In closing Mr. Steyer, we hope that we have misjudged you. We hope that you have visited the <u>Advanced Biofuels USA website</u> (<u>www.AdvancedBiofuelsUSA.org</u>) to learn about the science, technology, and emerging companies that could begin to make significant Climate Change reductions with the help of your timely investments; and that you are making such investment plans now.

But, if this is not the course you are taking, we have a hard time taking your commitment to reducing the causes of Climate Change seriously. Instead, we are forced to see your actions as those of another ultrarich fossil fuel investor who wants to play in the non-regulated power-broker game created by the Supreme Court's *Citizens United* decision.

Serious Fun: In 'Galileo's Torch,' "Unlikely Group of Washingtonians Debate Issue that Resonates"

From part of his biography, <u>Galileo: A Life</u>, **James Reston**, **Jr.**, transformed into a play, the account of Galileo Galilei's 17th century trial for asserting that the Earth moves around the sun.

He was egged on by the "genial and eccentric businessman named **John B. Henry**" who wanted to use this dramatic story of the never-ending struggle between religious belief and power with scientific observation and explanation to inaugurate the performance space created at a quarry on his Rappahannock County farm.

Henry then recruited friends and associates in prestigious positions in Washington to play the parts for a staged reading. From the biofuels world, Advanced Biofuels USA co-founder and treasurer, **Robert Kozak** portrayed an advisor to Cardinal Bellarmine played by **Richard Viguerie** ("modern conservatism's "funding father"), and ethanol fuel promotor/former Ambassador to the EU and former White House

counsel, **C. Boyden Gray**was Cardinal Maffeo
Barberini/Pope Urban VIII.

and props to bring the spectacle to life. And aptly demonstrating the extremes that we still live with today: the oppression in the name of religion, and the wonder and perceived threat of scientific knowledge; the use of power in civilian matters to make points related to military engagements; the fear of change exploited for political gain rather than tempered for practical achievements; and the military as a key source of funding for innovations. 
