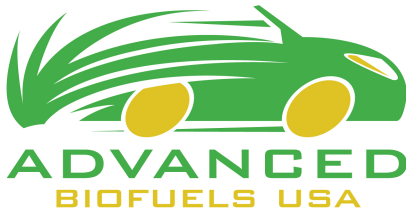

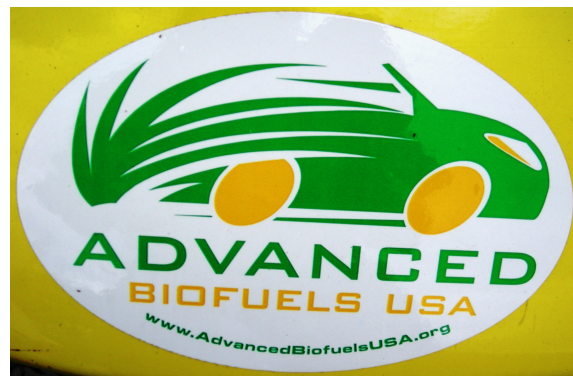

Advanced Biofuels USA board member, **Bob Kozak**, and executive director, **Joanne Ivancic**, attended the Advanced Biofuels Leadership Conference in Washington, DC in April. Thanks to Biofuels Digest, the organization had a table with our new stand-up display. See photo below. We were able to meet with federal agency staff, and had lunch at our booth with members of the delegation from the **International Energy Agency**. We discussed the [Roadmap](#) they unveiled at the conference, particularly the international indirect land use change elements. They agreed that sustainability criteria applied to biofuels crops should apply to all agriculture and forestry endeavors; that this is not a biofuels issue, but a land use issue.

Also in April, **Joanne Ivancic** attended the **Algal Biomass Organization's** Congressional briefing and Industry Award Reception on Captiol Hill. In addition to being able to meet leaders in this industry, she enjoyed the opportunity to talk with **Rear Admiral Philip Cullom** of the US Navy about plans for the **Great Green Fleet** and with **Senator Bill Nelson** (D-FL) about biofuels developments in Florida, particularly the work of another nonprofit organization, **American Biofuels NOW!**, located in Tampa and working to develop a biofuels industry in the Gulf States.

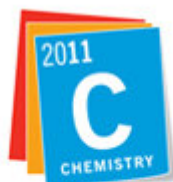
